WOMAN CHARGED WITH ATTEMPTED MURDER OF BOYFRIEND

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman accused of the attempted murder of her boyfriend.

Darci Bower (dob: 12-09-88) is charged with one count of *criminal attempt to commit murder in the first-degree* (F2), one count of *assault in the first-degree* (F3), and one count of *crime of violence* (se).

The charges allege that Bower stabbed the 31-year-old man once in the chest with a steak knife after an argument escalated into a physical altercation at their home in the 1300 block of Downing. The victim was taken to a local hospital.

Bower remains in custody; her bond has been set at \$35,000. She is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on June 12, 2009 at 9 a.m. to be advised of the charges.
