MAN CHARGED IN BOMB CLAIM

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey formally charged a man on Monday in connection with an incident that occurred last month at Denver International Airport.

Sergei Berejnoi (DOB: 12-30-60) is charged with one count of *endangering public transportation* (F3).

On October 31, 2010, Berejnoi arrived late to the gate for a flight to Salt Lake City at Denver International Airport. The charge alleges that, after being advised that he missed his flight, Berejnoi told an airline agent that there was a bomb in his luggage. The aircraft was immediately stopped and delayed for one hour while the cargo hold was search by a K-9 unit. No explosives were found.

Berejnoi has been released from custody on a \$15,000 bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on November 15, 2010, at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charge.
