TWO CHARGED IN PARKING TICKET FORGERY

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two men accused of conspiring to issue a fraudulent parking citation last year.

Eric Madril (dob: 04-08-80) is charged with *conspiracy to commit forgery* (F6).

John Culhane (dob: 09-24-66) is charged with *forgery* (F5) and *conspiracy to commit forgery* (F6).

The charges allege that on August 19, 2009 Madril conspired with Culhane to issue a fraudulent parking citation to a driver with whom Madril had earlier been involved in a verbal confrontation.

Both men have been released from custody on bond. Madril is scheduled to be formally advised of the charge against him on December 15, 2010. Culhane is scheduled to be formally advised on December 17, 2010.
