FORMER CITY EMPLOYEE SENTENCED

A former city employee who posed as a juvenile probation officer and provided alcohol and marijuana to a juvenile was been sentenced in Denver District Court earlier this week.

Richard de Olivas Sena y Cordova Real (dob: 06-11-62) pleaded guilty earlier to *contributing to the delinquency of a minor* (F4) and was sentenced on Monday to two years of probation, including serving 90 days in the Denver County Jail.

In February and March of 2009, De Olivas unlawfully posed as a juvenile probation officer, provided alcohol and marijuana to a juvenile. De Olivas worked as a manger in the Workforce Assessment and Training Unit of Denver's Office of Economic Development.
