### **THREE MEN CHARGED IN HOME INVASION ROBBERY**

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged three men in connection with a home invasion that took place on January 14, 2010.

**Douglas Holonbek** (dob: 09-04-68) is charged with five counts of *aggravated robbery* (F3), five counts of *menacing* (F5), *attempt to commit aggravated motor vehicle theft* (F5), and *possession of a weapon by a previous offender* (F6).

**Troy Davis Chase** (dob: 07-19-66) is charged with five counts of *aggravated robbery* (F3), five counts of *menacing* (F5), *attempt to commit aggravated motor vehicle theft* (F5), and *possession of a weapon by a previous offender* (F6).

**Wayne Christopher** (dob: 01-25-67) is charged with five counts of *aggravated robbery* (F3), five counts of *menacing* (F5), *attempt to commit aggravated motor vehicle theft* (F5).

On the evening of January 14, 2010, officers of the Denver Police Department were dispatched to the 8100 block of E. Fairmount Drive on a 911 hang up call. The charges allege that the three suspects forced entry into the home and held them at gun point.

**Holonbek, Chase, and Christopher** remain in the custody of Denver County Jail and are being held on \$75,000 bond. They are scheduled to appear for a formal advisement, in courtroom 472W, January 22, 2010 at 1 p.m.
