BROTHER AND SISTER CHARGED IN SERIES OF BURGLARIES

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man and a woman today in connection with a series of home burglaries in the Green Valley Ranch Community dating back to April 2010.

Mario Perez (DOB: 12/18/1990) is charged with two counts of *Second Degree Burglary* (F3). **Raquel Perez** (DOB: 8/1/89) is charged with three counts of *Second Degree Burglary* (F3). A third suspect, a juvenile, is also charged with five counts of *Second Degree Burglary* (F3).

The charges allege that the three defendants burglarized homes beginning in late April stealing flat screen televisions, jewelry and computers from these homes. Victims identified a black Ford Mustang that was reported to be involved in the string of burglaries. This vehicle was identified to one of the suspects in this case.

Mario Perez and Raquel Perez are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on August 6, 2010 at 10:30 am to be formally advised of the charges.
