MAN CHARGED WITH SEXUALLY ASSAULTING HIS CHILDREN

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of sexually assaulting three of his children over a period of nearly two decades.

David Tarver (DOB: 06-19-60) is charged with three counts of *sexual assault on a child* (F4), four counts of *sexual assault on a child by one in a position of trust* (F3), two counts of *sexual assault on a child, pattern of abuse* (F3), and two counts of *aggravated incest* (F3).

The charges allege that Tarver sexually assaulted at least three of his children over the course of many years, dating back to the late 1980s. The victims reported the alleged incidents after Tarver was arrested in January 2010, in Wyoming for sexually assaulting a grandchild.

Tarver remains in custody in the Laramie County Jail in Wyoming. A court date on today's charges filed in Denver has not yet been scheduled and it is likely that it will trail the Wyoming case. His bond is set at \$1,000,000.
