MAN FOUND GUILTY IN TATTOO PARLOR MURDER

A man charged with the robbery and subsequent shooting death of a tattoo parlor owner in 2008 has been convicted today by a Denver jury.

Tyrone Williams (DOB: 05-23-1977) was found guilty of *first-degree felony murder* (F1) and three counts of aggravated robbery (F3).

On August 22, 2007, at approximately 10:30 p.m., Denver Police officers were called to a shooting at 6640 East Colfax Avenue. The charges allege that Williams and a co-defendant entered the tattoo parlor with weapons, demanded money, and then fatally shot the owner, 27-year-old Joshua Trobaugh.

Williams faces life in prison without parole when he sentenced on August 20, 2010 at 1:30 p.m. in Denver District Courtroom 4H.
