WOMAN SENTENCED IN HIT AND RUN

A woman who was found guilty of causing a fatal crash while driving drunk the wrong way on I-25 last year has been sentenced in Denver District Court today.

Victoria Barry (dob: 06-13-84) was found guilty earlier this summer of two counts of *vehicular homicide* (F3, F4), *DUI* (M1), and one count of *third-degree assault* (M1). Barry has been sentenced to ten years in prison. She was given 10 years for vehicular homicide, six years for reckless driving, two years for third degree assault, and one year for DUI in department of corrections, but the judge ordered that they all served concurrently for a total of 10 years.

Barry was drunk and was driving southbound in the northbound lanes of I-25 at about 11:40 p.m. on May 14, 2011. She crashed into a car driven by 31-year-old Lilly Duncan of Colorado Springs; Duncan died at the scene. She also crashed into a second car, injuring another person.

Mothers Against Drunk Driving and the Denver District Attorney's Office have placed a memorial sign on the corner of Lincoln Street & Ohio Street, the I-25 off-ramp where Ms. Duncan would have exited to go home.
