TWO CHARGED IN MAY 25TH SHOOTING

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two men in connection with a shooting that occurred on May 25, 2012 in the 3300 block of Bruce Randolph Avenue. The shooting left two people dead and two others injured.

Marquise Lovelle Davis (dob: 11-05-88) and Denzel Richardson (dob: 10-24-91) are each charged with four counts of first degree murder (F1), four counts of attempted murder (F2), two counts of first-degree assault (F3), one count of second-degree assault (F4) and one count of conspiracy to commit murder (F2).

The charges allege that on May 25, 2012, at about 2 p.m., Davis and Richardson went to the area of Bruce Randolph Avenue and York Street and opened fire into a group of people standing on the sidewalk. Justin O'Donnell and Deon Rudd were killed; two others were injured.

Davis and Richardson were identified as suspects by Denver police detectives and were arrested a few days later. They remain in custody in the Denver Detention Center where they are being held without bond. They are scheduled to appear in Denver District Courtroom 5H on Thursday, June 7th at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
