CHARGES FILED AGAINST THE “POT BELLY BANDIT” AND THE “PRETTY IN PINK BANDIT”

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has separately charged two men in connection with a series of bank robberies.

Wayman Herrington (dob: 02-03-87) is charged with three counts of *aggravated robbery* (F3) in connection with a series of robberies in Denver between January 26th and 30th. Known as “The Pot Belly Bandit,” he was arrested following a Crime Stoppers tip and is a suspect in other robberies in other metro area jurisdictions.

Dustin Sharon (dob: 09-16-86) is charged with five counts of *aggravated robbery* (F3) in connection with a series of robberies in Denver between January 12th and 30th. Known as the “Pretty In Pink” bandit, he was arrested shortly after the last robbery when a witness was able to get part of a license plate number. He is suspected of additional robberies in the metro area.

Herrington remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center; his bond is set at \$150,000. Sharon remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center; his bond is set at \$400,000.

Both defendants are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on February 9, 2012 at 9:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
