MOM CHARGED AS ACCESSORY IN DAUGHTER'S HIT/RUN CRASH

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged, as an accessory, the mother of a woman charged last month in a hit and run crash.

Kimberly Jacobs (dob: 02-10-67) is charged with being an *accessory after the fact* (F5).

The charge alleges that Jacobs impeded an active investigation into the hit and run crash.

Her daughter, Taylor Mathis, was charged in January with leaving the scene of an accident causing serious bodily injury and driving under revocation; she is accused of running into two pedestrians at Colfax Avenue and Ogden Street on January 23, 2012. Jacobs allegedly knew her daughter had been involved, but refused to provide information about the location of either her daughter or the vehicle involved.

Jacobs, who was taken into custody in Aurora, has been released from custody on a \$10,000 bond. She is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Wednesday, February 22, 2012, at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charge.
