WOMAN CHARGED WITH CAR THEFT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman accused of stealing a car from a gas station and then being involved in a hit and run crash.

Breanna Ocana (dob: 05-18-88) is charged today with *aggravated motor vehicle theft (F4) duty to report an accident (T2)* and *driving under revocation (M)*.

The charges allege, on June 2012, Ocana stole a car from a gas station in the 1000 block of Federal Boulevard while the victim was inside paying for gas. The charges further allege Ocana caused an accident near Santa Fe and Alameda Avenue, and then left the scene of the crash in a cab. The cab dropped her back at the scene of the car theft, where she was arrested.

Ocana has been released from custody on a \$5,000 bond. She is not yet scheduled to appear for her second advisement.
