CHARGES FILED IN BARRICADE CASE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey formally charged a man yesterday who is accused of shooting at police and other crimes as part of a seven-hour stand-off last week.

Ryon Olthoff (dob: 09-09-76) was charged yesterday with two counts of attempted murder (F2), two counts of first-degree assault (F3), one count of first-degree burglary (F3), two counts of false imprisonment (M2), two counts of third-degree assault (M1) and one count of possession of a weapon by a previous offender (F6).

The charges allege that following a domestic violence incident on Wednesday, September 12, 2012, Olthoff shot at police officers before barricading himself inside a building at 3rd Avenue and Santa Fe Drive.

Olthoff remains in custody; his bond is set at \$200,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 tomorrow, September 21, 2012, at 9:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
