WIG OUT BANDIT FORMALLY CHARGED

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man suspected of being “The Wig Out Bandit” today in connection with nine bank robberies. The arrest and charges are the result of work by the FBI Rocky Mountain Safe Streets Task Force.

Stanley Paige (dob: 10-06-58) is charged with nine counts of *aggravated robbery* (F3).

The charges allege that Paige committed nine bank robberies in Denver beginning last August. The robberies continued until January 5, 2012 when Paige was arrested shortly after a robbery was reported at a bank near 37th Avenue and Quebec Street.

Paige remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center; his bond is set at \$75,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Tuesday, January 17, 2012, to be formally advised of the charges.

The presumptive range for sentencing on a class 3 felony is up to 12 years in prison on each count.
