CHARGES FILED IN MURDER AT THE HIVE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of shooting and killing a 47-year-old father outside a nightclub last weekend.

Marvin Rosario-Lopez (dob: 05-06-88) is charged today with *first-degree murder after deliberation* (F1) and *first-degree murder with extreme indifference* (F1).

The charges allege that in the early morning hours of Sunday, November 4, 2012, Rosario-Lopez was involved in an altercation outside of a nightclub in the 1100 block of Lincoln Street and that he pulled a gun and shot Ronald Smith. Smith later died.

Rosario-Lopez was detained by security guards at the scene, and was taken into custody without further incident by Denver police officers. He remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center where he is being held without bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver District Courtroom 5H on November 13, 2012.
