MAN CHARGED IN CASE OF BODY FOUND IN ALLEY

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused in the shooting death of a 27-year-old man whose body was found in an alley on June 16, 2012.

Jamie Valdiviezo-Perea (dob: 04-10-73) is charged with first-degree murder (F1) and two counts of menacing (F5).

The charges allege that in the early morning hours of June 16, 2012, Valdiviezo-Perea was involved in a confrontation with the victim, Juan Hernandez-Soto, and shot and killed him in an apartment on South Quivas Street. The charges further allege that Valdiviezo-Perea menaced two other people as he wrapped the victim's body in a blanket and removed it from the apartment.

Valdiviezo-Perea remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center where he is being held without bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver District Courtroom 5H on Wednesday, June 27, 2012 at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
