CHARGES FILED IN ESCAPE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a sex offender accused of escaping from custody two weeks ago.

Eugene Martinez (dob: 06-22-65) is charged with *escape* (F4) and *failure to register as a sex offender* (F6).

The charges allege that Martinez was required to register as a sex offender and failed to do so, and that on October 9, 2013, while he was being processed on that charge, he freed himself from handcuffs and escaped custody.

Martinez was arrested in Boulder last weekend, and remains in custody there. His next Denver court date has not yet been set.
