CHARGES FILED IN DOUBLE-MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of shooting and killing two young women last week in an apartment at 3225 South Parker Road.

Jose King (dob: 12-13-91) is charged with two counts of *first-degree murder* (F1).

The charges allege that on October 29, 2014, at about 11:10 p.m., King shot and killed 19-year-old Amanda Anders and 22-year-old Nancy Worrell following an argument. King fled the scene and was arrested a short time later by Castle Rock Police.

King remains in custody and is being held without bond. His next court date will be set later today.
