TWO CHARGED IN ROBBERY OF UBER DRIVER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two people in connection with the robbery of an Uber driver that occurred last December.

Wenston Williams (10-30-64) is charged with *aggravated robbery* (F3), *first-degree assault* (F3) and three counts of *possession of a weapon by a previous offender* (F6).

A co-defendant, **Kimberly Kovinchick** (dob: 11-13-82) is charged with *aggravated robbery* (F3) and *first-degree assault* (F3).

The charges allege that on December 31, 2014, Williams and Kovinchick met the victim, a 55-year-old man working as an Uber driver, near 33rd Avenue and Ivanhoe Street and then robbed him at knifepoint after driving to another location.

Kovinchick was identified as a suspect soon after the incident and was arrested earlier this year; she is scheduled to appear in Denver District Courtroom 5C for arraignment in October. The investigation has continued, and Williams was arrested earlier this week and remains in custody; his bond is set at \$50,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on September 28, 2015, at 8:30 a.m., to be formally advised of the charges.
