MAN RECEIVES PROBATION IN ATTEMPTED ASSAULT ON A POLICE OFFICER

A man accused of causing a disturbance at a grocery store and attempting to assault a police officer was given probation today in Denver County Court.

Robert Bemoras (dob: 06-09-1964) was originally charged with attempted first-degree assault on a peace officer (F4), menacing (F5), and three counts of third-degree assault on a peace officer (M1).

Bemoras was given a two-year deferred judgment to the F4 count and supervised probation for a period of two years.
