MAN CHARGED IN ROAD RAGE MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of shooting and killing a driver who had flipped him off.

David Alberto Garcia (dob: 08-10-88) is charged with one count of *first-degree murder* (F1).

The charge alleges that on November 26, 2016, Garcia shot and killed 28-year-old Miguel Baray after a brief dispute at a stop sign at Kentucky Avenue and Irving Street. Garcia is accused of driving up alongside Baray and fatally shooting him after Baray had displayed his middle finger. Garcia was allegedly driving a stolen vehicle at the time of the incident.

Garcia remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center. His next court date has not yet been set.
