I am a police officer for the City and County of Denver, Colorado, and have knowledge regarding the arrest/incident of the above named party for the below listed offense, which offense occurred on or about the date of 06/20/2017 at 4:53 pm at or near the location of 1400 N PERRY ST in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

The probable cause of the arrest of the above-named individual is as follows:
[On Saturday, June 24th, 2017 at approximately 2241 Hrs your Affiant, Officer R. Moser, 15076; a Police Officer in the City and County of Denver, responded to the 3100 Blk of W Avondale Dr to assist a private security company who advised that they had a theft from motor vehicle suspect detained.

Upon arrival your Affiant spoke with security and was advised that when they detained the subject he advised that he had a "BB gun" and a "meth pipe" in his back pack. Security advised that they removed his back pack for their safety.

Your Affiant contacted the Defendant who identified himself as Charles Bisonette, 06/28/1995. Your Affiant conducted an MDT search of the Defendants name/DOB and found that he was listed as a suspect in a Felony Menacing case that had occurred on 06/20/2017. Your Affiant reviewed the statements related to the Felony Menacing case (17-403899) and found the following statement from the reporting officer:

" The victim stated that he was walking down the 1400 Blk of N Perry St and the suspect (BISONETTE CHARLES 01/28/1995) walked out of the McDonalds (4020 W Colfax Ave) with two other male subjects(TWO OTHER MALES HM RED MUSCLE SHIRT BLK SHORTS BLK SHORTS WHI TSHIRT EB COLFAX PERRY) and began to yell at him and [REDACTED]. The victim stated they stopped and turned to see the suspect take off his back pack and place it on the sidewalk. At that time the suspect put his right hand into the back pack and pulled out a silver handgun. The victim stated the suspect pointed the silver handgun at him and [REDACTED] and began to approach them stating "what G". The victim advised me he was scared and at that time he and [REDACTED] started to walk SB on N Perry St".

Further review of the statement found that the victim and the Defendant were friends and that the victim provided the reporting officer with the Defendants name. Due to their relationship the victim was showed a web-mug of the Defendant and he positively identified Charles Bisonette as the person who menaced him.

The statement also stated that the weapon used in the incident was a silver handgun. This was relayed by both the victim and a witness.

Officers searched the bag that was on the Defendants back when he was contacted by security. Inside the black back pack officers located a meth pipe and a silver metal revolver BB gun. This weapon perfectly matched the description of the weapon that was used by the Defendant in the Felony Menacing on 06/20/2017.

Reference the theft of motor vehicle, due to the victim vehicle leaving the area, officers were unable to locate a victim so no charges could be pursued. Officers contacted District 1 Investigations and were advised to place the suspect on a hold for Felony Menacing.
